

MHSA Prevention and Early Intervention

Starting July 1, 2026 Prevention and Early Intervention will sunset as a program. New regulatory requirements of the Behavioral Health Services Act (BHSA) will result in the following changes in Riverside County:

- Prevention services will no longer be funded with local county dollars
