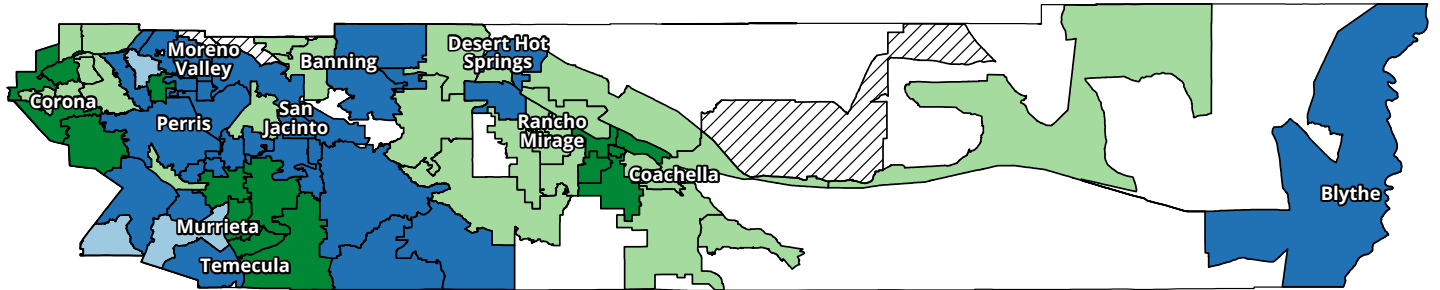
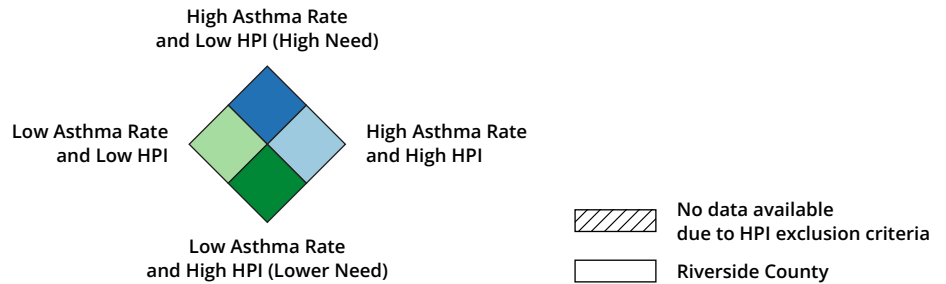

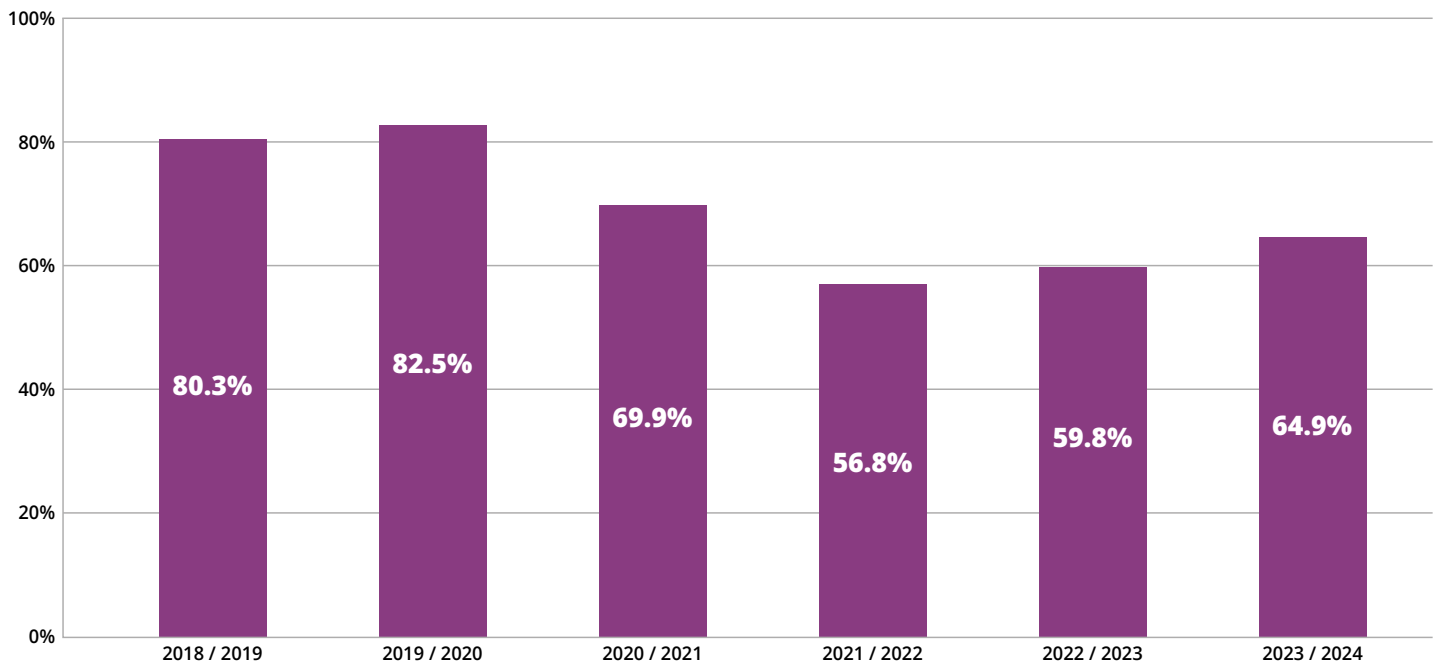


Asthma ED Visits Age Adjusted Rates from 2018 to 2022

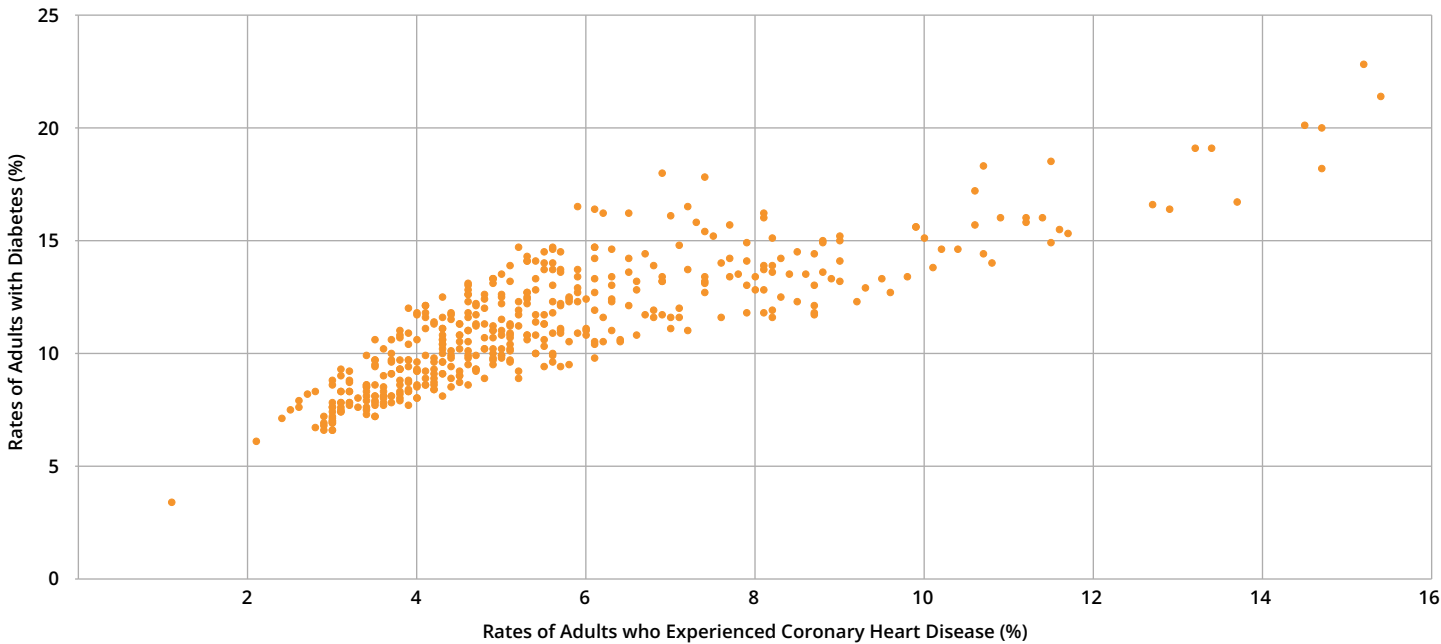
Influenza Vaccination Rate Among Healthcare Providers is Increasing But Has Not Returned to Pre-Pandemic Rates

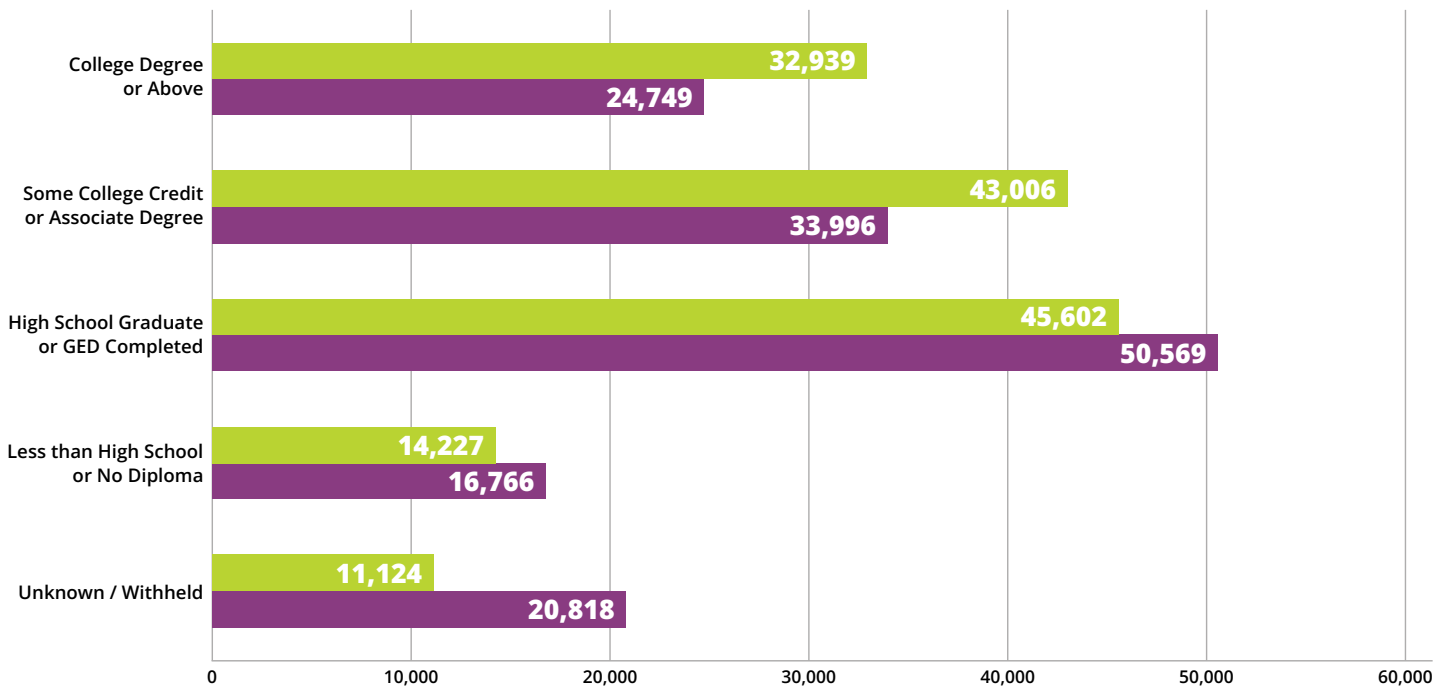
Strong Positive Linear Correlation (r=0.84) Shown between Adults who Experienced Coronary Heart Disease and Adults with Diabetes

Birthing Parents Had Higher Levels of Education Compared to Non-Birthing Parents between 2018-2022



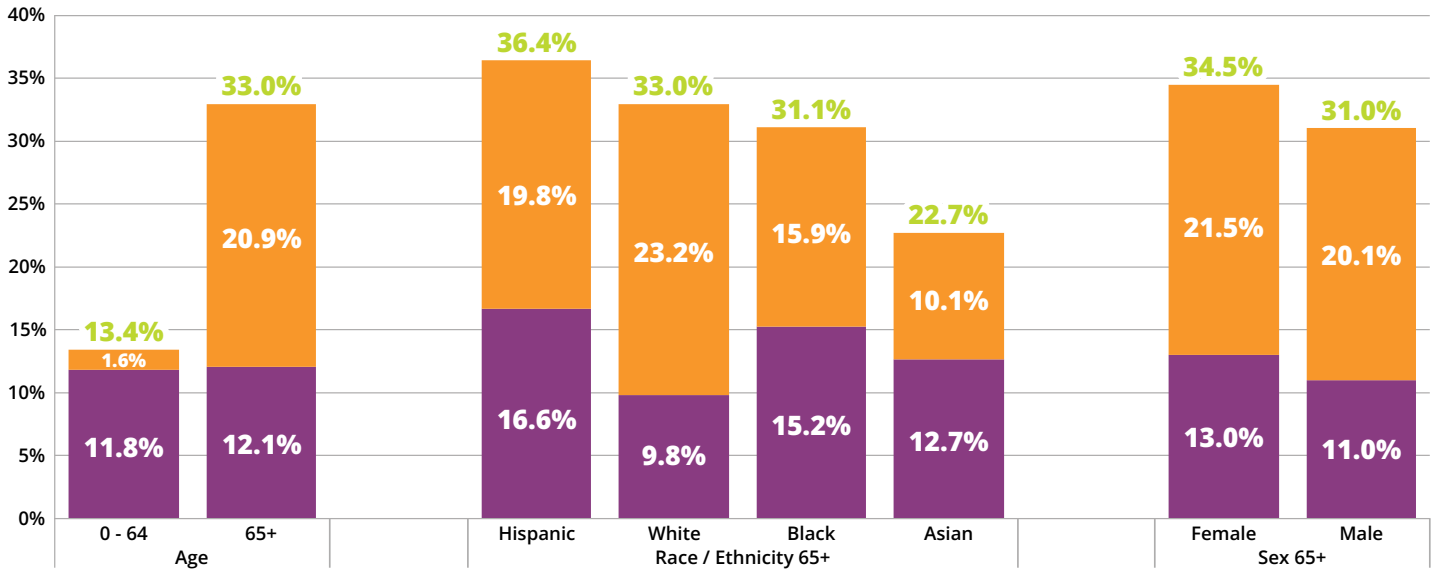

A High Percentage of the Population Would be in High Poverty Status if They Did Not Receive Social Security

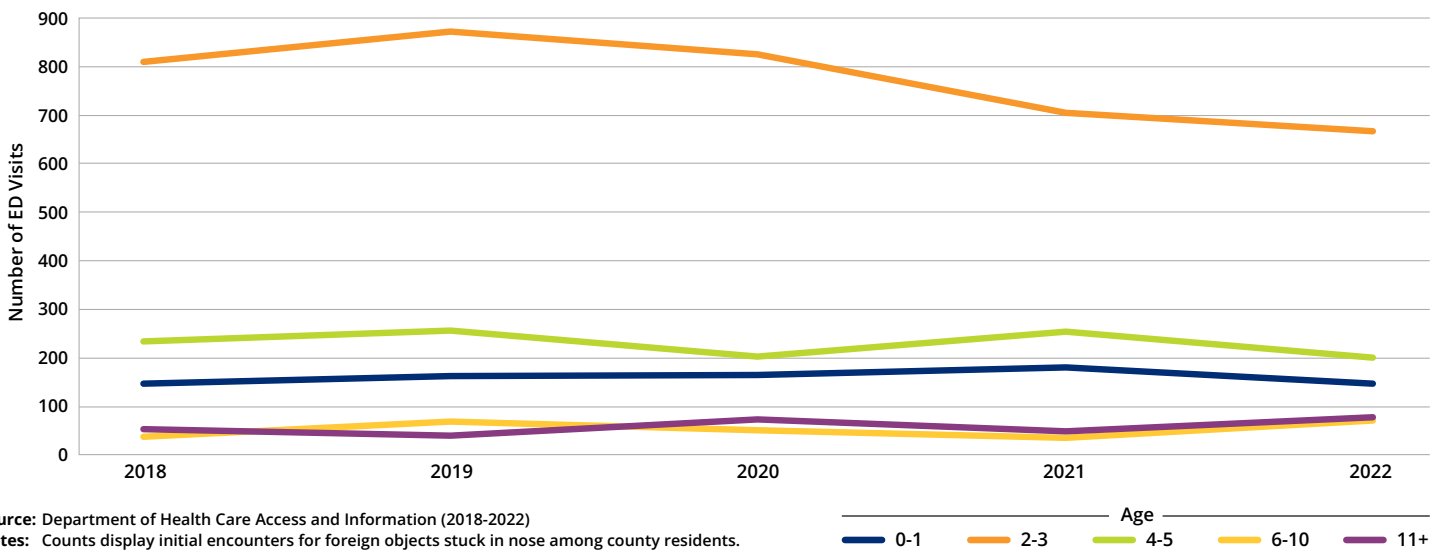
