

Figure 3: Methamphetamine and Fentanyl Combination Overdose Deaths by Year




Figure 4: Xylazine Related Overdose Deaths by Year






Figure 7: Count of Fatal Overdoses by Race / Ethnicity





Figure 8: Count Overdose Deaths* among People Experiencing Homelessness by Year



Figure 12: Count of Drug-Related Emergency Department Visits by Age (All Drugs) September 2024







Figure 13: Count of All Drug VS Opioid-Related Visits To the Emergency October 1, 2023 - September 30, 2024
